

Numbers, Novels, and Nebulae: An Assortment of Algorithmic Applications

Princeton Chapter of ACM / IEEE Computer Society will close its 2014-2015 season of monthly meetings with our annual dinner meeting.

This talk will be a survey, illustrated with numerous examples, of unusual applications of computer algorithms in recreational mathematics, logology (linguistics and experimental literature), and backyard astrophotography. At this Pi+2 Day (5.14.15) event, attendees will learn about the world's largest alphabetic, interesting new applications of the hill-climbing strategy, and the remarkable properties of the "stacking" algorithm that is used to capture amazing photographs of the universe through a telescope.

Mike Keith received his B.S.E.E. from NJIT in 1977 and M.S.E.E. from Stanford University in 1978. He was employed at the David Sarnoff Research Center in the 1980's, where he worked on various projects related to personal computing. At Intel Corporation in the 1990's he invented and implemented digital video/audio compression algorithms, and at Ambric Incorporated in the 2000's he developed massively-parallel software. Mike is the author of 50+ papers and three books, and holds 75 U.S. patents. His Erdos-Bacon number is 7. Mike's Website <www.cadaeic.net> attracts world-wide attention, especially around Pi Day

- Turn left at the stop sign (onto Edgebrook Rd.)
